Tips for applying for scholarships

- Make a resume + list of personal references and update them occasionally
- If you'll need recommendation letters, give references plenty of time, a copy of your resume, and statement of goals/interests
- 3. Keep track of program details (deadlines, specific info requests)
- 4. Write your own essays!
- 5. Proofread!!
